4. AGE :

- 4.1 Not more than **45 years** as on **1st July, 2009**. Relaxable as per Rules.
- 4.2 The age limit may be relaxed by five years in case of a candidate already in service of the Government of Maharashtra.

5. QUALIFICATIONS : Candidates must possess qualifications in appropriate subject.....

- 5.1 An eminent scholar with published work of high quality, actively engaged in research, with 10 years of experience in postgraduate teaching, and / or experience in research at the University / National Level Institutions, including experience of guiding research at doctoral level. **OR**
- 5.2 An outstanding scholar with established reputation who has made significant contribution to knowledge.

6. DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES : The details regarding duties and responsibilities of the post are available on web site of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission.

7. GENERAL : Selected candidates will be on probation for a period of two years.

8. NOTES

- 8.1 For published work of high quality status at least 5 international publications or 10 national publications in refereed journals is preferable, in journals with impact factor > 1.5.
- 8.2 The candidates who claim the published work or experience of research at the University / National Level Institution, are required to attach the list of publications with details or list of Research projects with details. The projects should be externally funded research projects of National level Government / Semi Government organisations such as UGC, CSIR, DST, ICSSR and such other institutions.
- 8.3 Teaching experience should be in post in higher education and should be approved by the University and / or State Government, as the case may be, and should be of full time appointment for a complete academic term.

- 8.4 The Commission at its discretion, may shortlist the applicants for interview based on reasonable criteria i.e. experience and/or higher qualification, etc. OR may conduct Written objective type screening test (multiple choice question) to shortlist the candidates for interview. The syllabus and medium of question paper and other details for the test shall be displayed on the Commission's Website.
- 8.5 Copies of certificates should not be attached along with the Application Form. However, candidates are required to furnish an affidavit on a stamp paper of Rs.100/- to be affirmed before Notary in respect of correctness and authenticity of the information mentioned in the application form. Specimen of affidavit is published on the Commission's web site in the 'Specimen Form of Affidavit for Direct Recruitment Posts' section.
- 8.6 The Application Form should be accompanied by an affidavit. Failing which it is treated as incomplete and will be rejected.
- 8.7 The candidate should submit all the original certificates alongwith one set of zerox copies at the time of interview as per instruction given in chapter-4 of the prospectus provided alongwith the application form.
